REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS IN RESPECT OF THE ZONE 1 AND ZONE 2
CASINO LICENCES

Notice is hereby given that the final Requests for Proposals (RFPs) in respect of the Zone 1 and Zone 2 casino licences ("the casino RFPs") in the Eastern Cape will be available from the Eastern Cape Gambling Board on **Monday, 13 October 2025** and not Monday, 01 September 2025 for Zone 1 Casino Licence and Wednesday, 01 October 2025 for Zone 2 Casino Licence as previously published on 01 September 2025.

Zone 1 covers the magisterial districts of Aberdeen, Alexandria, Bathurst, Bedford, Despatch, Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth), Hankey, Humansdorp, iKhobonqaba (Adelaide), Jansenville, Jeffrey's Bay, Joubertina, Kariega (Uitenhage), Kirkwood, KwaMaqoma (Fort Beaufort), KwaNojoli (Somerset East), Makhanda (Grahamstown), Pearston, Steytlerville and Willowmore.

Zone 2 covers the magisterial districts of Alice, Butterworth/Gcuwa, East London, Dutywa, Centane, Keiskammahoek, Qonce (King William's Town), Komga/Qumrha, Mdantsane, Middledrift, Ngqamakwe, Peddie/Nqgushwa, Seymour, Stutterheim, Tsomo, Willowvale, and Zwelitsha.

The purpose of the casino RFPs is to invite applications for the Zone 1 and Zone 2 casino licences ("the casino licences") from the public. The casino RFPs set out, amongst other things, the requirements for the casino development, the evaluation criteria that will be applied, the essential minimum requirements with which an application must comply, the consequences of non-compliance, and the evaluation process. The casino RFPs constitute the basis of the evaluation for the application for a casino licence.

The casino licences shall, subject to the provisions of the Eastern Cape Gambling Act, 1997 (as amended) **be valid for a fixed period of twenty (20) years.**


THE CLOSING DATES FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS SHALL BE:



• THURSDAY, 29 JANUARY 2026 AT 11H00 (SOUTH AFRICAN STANDARD TIME) FOR BOTH ZONE 1 AND ZONE 2 CASINO LICENCES.

The cost of the casino RFP is R6,300.00 (six thousand three hundred rand). Applicants are required to request copies of the casino RFPs by sending an e-mail, together with proof of payment to compliance@ecgb.org.za and ceo@ecgb.org.za. Please note that only applicants who have purchased the casino RFP will be eligible to submit an application for a casino licence.
